Successful completion of this test is a requirement for graduating from high school in Ontario with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma. The Ministry mandates that the OSSLT must occur at the school using a Board computer with the OSSLT programing. A computer and all materials will be provided by the school for the student on the day of the test.

The test is approximately 2.5 hours and extra time can be provided if required.
